Title of Topic:	Framework for Portal questions	30 min
Background:	We've acknowledged the need to adopt a framework for addressing the question, "How healthy is my estuary?" on the pubic portal.	
	At the last meeting Val presented an approach for using the framework for summarizing fish data. We are proposing adopting a similar structure to the State of the SF Bay Report (SOTB, 2011) for the portal, where key estuarine attributes are the basis for breaking down the estuary - delivering ecosystem health information in a coarse, digestible format for the general public.	
	State of the Bay estuarine attributes were developed using EPA's key attributes for an ecological system. The estuarine attributes identified in the SOTB include the following:	

	Water, Habitat, Living Resources, Ecological Processes, and
	Stewardship (Although not an estuarine attribute, the report also evaluates human actions that reduce impacts on the ecosystem)
	Due to current data available in the website, there will be an initial focus on foobweb questions for now. Volunteers for future focus topics are desired.
Desired Outcome:	Decision: Approval of SOTB framework as a guide and process
