	3. – A new version Bay Delta Live will be released in December, which will include a lot of fisheries updates. RMP data visualization tools to be added to the Sacramento River Watershed (SRW) portal. SRW portal working in Battle Creek to conduct EPA watershed assessment with Water Board and working with Sierra Nevada Conservancy, USFS, USFWS, CAFWL for landscape level assessments for forest restoration with impacts on water quality.

Kris Jones updated the CEMW on these efforts, and indicated the he would be presenting at the January, IEP Science Management Team (SMT) meeting to seek approval and feedback for working with IEP and SMT toward these goals.</li> <li>Kris Jones also discussed the relationship with other efforts such as Bay Delta Live – how do we want to work with them and collaborate with them moving forward? Clear explanation of each portal's role and data sets is needed. It was mentioned that the Estuaries Portal's strength is that it provides contex and is curated.
