- CalEPA Secretary and Undersecretary
  - Demonstrate Council usefulness
    - Tie efforts to high-profile issues of administration
    - Support decision-making with data and information
- Subcommittee deliberations
  - Be more opportunistic
    - Harmful algal blooms
    - Delta support EcoRestore and WaterFix
    - Dashboards to support agency management decisions
    - Support both statewide and regional efforts
    - Incorporate water supply were relevant
  - New legislation needed to provide direction and funding

### Strategy Implementation

- More-fully engage additional state and federal governmental organizations
  - Commit personnel to workgroup actions
  - Provide additional resources
- Provide greater representation so as to influence Council and workgroup direction to better align with organizational needs – options
