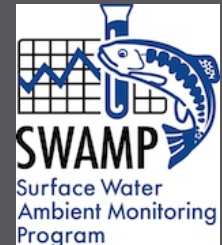
LEVEL 1 LANDSCAPE ASSESSMENT



LEVEL 2 RAPID ASSESSMENT

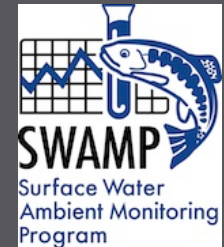
