 (e.g., Heal the Bay, Waterkeepers, SCCWRP, SFEI, citizen monitoring groups)
 - Regulated community
- Needs Identification
 - o What data sets and assessment tools are needed?
 - Who are the key players (i.e., sources of data and assessment tools)?
 - o What other workgroups share overlapping subject matter?
 - Establish relationships for sharing and cooperation
- Problems Assessment:
 - o What are potential barriers to success?
 - Institutional (e.g., data ownership, data access)
 - Technical (e.g., data management, web capabilities, GIS platform differences)
 - Funding / Resources
 - o Are there critical players who are unable or unwilling to participate?
