

- Formally kicked off at meeting in Sept.
  2008
  - Ø Broad range of participants
  - Consensus on diagnosis of problem / opportunity
  - Basic agreement to develop program in phases
- Follow-up Governance meeting in Nov. 2008
  - Focused on set of specific issues
  - Agreed to wait for two products
  - Produced strawman proposal

#### Phase 1


- Focus on mechanisms for regularly compiling, assessing, and reporting data from existing, on-going monitoring efforts
- Visible, tangible product such as a "Pulse of the Delta" type of synthesis report
- Build interest, involvement, and momentum




