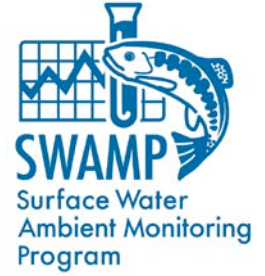

This would be one element of an overarching plan to periodically sample sport fish in water bodies of interest in all major categories (lakes, rivers and streams, the coast, including subcategories). Revisit frequencies would vary by category. After the general scope for 2015 is decided, SFEI and Moss Landing will flesh out the details of the plan for discussion at our next meeting.
